partition number,
rows,
ROW NUMBER() OVER(PARTITION BY object id, index id, partition number ORDER BY
partition id) as rn
FROM sys.partitions
SELECT
object_name(cur.object_id) as TableName,
cur.index id,
cur.partition number,
PrecentDone =
CASE
WHEN pre.rows = 0 THEN 0
ELSE
((cur.rows * 100.0) / pre.rows)
END,
pre.rows - cur.rows as MissingRows
FROM cte as cur
INNER JOIN cte as pre on (cur.object id = pre.object id) AND (cur.index id = pre.index id)
AND (cur.partition number = pre.partition number) AND (cur.rn = pre.rn +1)
ORDER BY 4
```
